Upon notification, you must provide the following to the Going Rural Health via email using the following address going-ruralhealth@unimelb.edu.au

- Copy of the placement acceptance letter
- Return the F04 form that will be emailed to you with instructions, completed with your banking details for payment. (NON UOM Students Only – UOM students need not complete this form)

At the midpoint of your placement, you will be required to:

- Submit a 'Midpoint Proof of Placement'.

At the completion of your placement, you will need to:

- Register on the Going Rural Health Website and complete the online placement survey.

- Submit the Completion Proof of Placement document.
- Complete a brief written evaluation of your placement
- Complete an end of placement interview – you will be notified in advance if this is required
